PURPOSE

This document shows the detailed procedure for amending counterparty SSI group in the system.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

This allows amending counterparty SSI group when required for reporting purposes.

PROCEDURE

1. From the main menu, select Set Up > Static > Settlement Instructions.



2. Click Counterparty SSI.



3. Click SSI Group. The Counterparty SSI Group screen displays.



4. Click on the short name of the counterparty SSI group to amend.




5. Make the necessary changes.




- 6. Click Save .
- 7. Approve the amended group by ticking on the checkbox beside the short name.




8. Click Approve. A popup appears to confirm, click OK.



9. To amend the counterparty SSI group member assignment, click on the short name of the counterparty SSI group.




- 10. In the Amend Counterparty SSI Group screen, click Assign Member.
