PURPOSE

This document shows the detailed procedure on how to create a forecast cycle.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

Forecast cycles allow the maintenance of rolling forecasts in the CS Lucas system.

PROCEDURE



1. From the main menu, select Cash Management > Forecasting > Maintenance > Cycle. The Forecast Cycle screen displays.

6. In the Status field, choose whether the cycle is Open or Hidden. Default is Open and updating is allowed. If hidden, it will not show up in the Cycle drop-down field in the Operational Forecast screen.
