
This document contains the procedure for importing actual financial covenants for entities.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?


This allows to import actual financial covenants in bulk if you have many to maintain and can be import for multiple entities.

- 3. From the Amend Accounting Centre screen, click Financial Covenants.




4. Click Import. The Import Financial Covenants screen


displays.


- 8. Go back to the Import Financial Covenants screen, tick on Read File checkbox.

10. Click Read File. The values inputted in the Excel File will displays.




- 11. If there is an error, the user will be prompted with the rows to be corrected. To make corrections, go to the Excel file to make the necessary corrections and click Read File again.
